SUBJECT: 2015 Environmental Policy Statement

1. Scott Air Force Base is committed to conducting its mission in a responsible manner that will protect human health, natural resources, and the environment. Team Scott is dedicated to environmental sustainability through continual improvement of our processes and methodologies that reduce environmental risks, promote pollution prevention, and meet regulatory requirements while allowing mission completion.

2. Team Scott is dedicated to sustaining our natural resources infrastructure. The Team Scott Environmental Management System (EMS) is applicable to all organizations of the 375 AMW and tenants located within the fence line of Scott AFB. Team Scott is committed to:

- Understanding and communicating environmental requirements to all levels and parties;
- Providing management oversight and adequate training to instill environmental stewardship, ensure understanding of the EMS and its requirements, and obtain a commitment to compliance;
- Preventing pollution and leveraging new and innovative technologies and practices to minimize the generation of wastes; recycling materials otherwise destined to become waste whenever possible and disposing of any remaining wastes in an environmentally responsible manner;
- Implementing streamlined performance-based approaches to improve clean-up efforts to restore and protect natural infrastructure resources;
- Adopting proactive approaches for a renewed emphasis on energy conservation including adoption of innovative practices and procedures that conserve energy and improve efficiency, plus use all funding avenues to leverage replacement of failing, inefficient systems with more energy efficient systems;

- Accepting legal responsibility and accountability for our activities and decisions that impact human health, safety, and the continued viability of natural resources. To measure our success, we will establish goals, conduct annual evaluations to determine conformance with requirements and assess the performance in achieving the goals, objectives, and projected targets;
- Partnering with local agencies and community groups to communicate EMS requirements and minimize environmental impacts while pursuing opportunities for environmental excellence.

3. Compliance with this environmental policy is the responsibility of every member of the Scott AFB community in accordance with their roles and responsibilities in the organization and adherence should serve as a guideline for measuring our success.
