SUBJECT: Scott Air Force Base HPCON Bravo, Mask Guidance, and Exemption for

Workplace Occupancy Limits

Disease 2019 Force Health Protection Guidance

1. This guidance consolidates, incorporates, and rescinds the 22 July 2022 Scott Air Force Base COVID-19 Mask Wear policy memorandum.

- 2. Reference (a) provides authority to determine Health Protection Conditions (HPCON) levels, mask and screening requirements, and allows for installation commanders to grant exemptions for workplace occupancy limits. For the purposes of this memo, "workplace" is defined as Scott Air Force Base (SAFB).
- 3. SAFB will continue HPCON Bravo due to the current St. Clair County, IL COVID-19 CDC Community Levels being listed as Medium. SAFB Commanders, Directors, and Agency Chiefs are authorized to allow up to 100 percent workplace occupancy with telework implemented as deemed appropriate to accomplish their specific mission, while also maintaining a safe work environment.
- 4. Supervisors will coordinate with Civilian Personnel prior to returning any civilian employees to the workplace.
- 5. Additionally, regardless of vaccination status, DoD personnel and visitors are no longer required to wear a mask on SAFB as long as the CDC COVID-19 Community Level remains medium or low in St. Clair County, IL.
- 6. The SAFB team will continue to monitor data concerning COVID-19 case rates and vaccinations to deliberately adjust HPCON levels and measures as needed to retain combat capabilities.
