MEMORANDUM FOR SCOTT AIR FORCE BASE

SUBJECT: Re-Establishment of Authorized Local Travel Radius for Scott Air Force Base

1. On 13 March 2020, the Deputy Secretary of Defense issued a Stop Movement order for Domestic Travel. In that order, he restricted all DoD funded travel outside of the local area and all military members from leaving the local area unless granted an exception to the Stop Movement order. That order was re-issued on 20 April 2020.
2. On 18 March 2020, AF/A1 provided clarification on the definition of local area for leave taken during COVID-19. On 26 March 2020, I defined the local leave and travel radius for both authorized leave and for ordinary off-duty activities as 50 miles from a member's residence. The previous 50-mile radius is hereby expanded to 250 miles until the DoD Stop Movement Order is rescinded. This radius is 250 miles from an Airman's residence, or "where an Airman lives and from which he or she commutes to the duty station" per AF/A1 memo *Definition of Local Area for Leave Taken During Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Response*, dated 18 March 2020.
3. This change in policy comes with restrictions. Most importantly, all Airmen must continue to adhere to all Centers for Disease Control Guidance for social distancing and use of face masks when they are unable, or not expected to be able to maintain a 6-foot distance from the next person (e.g., inside places of business). Furthermore, Airmen should avoid large gatherings at any leave or off-duty location, but especially in high density cities or metropolitan areas which could increase their risk of exposure to COVID-19. Finally, Airmen must comply with all state and local orders concerning travel, health, and safety.
